- 5 We own and operate our 2 ships:** We are the only U.S. company who owns and operates two ships in the Galápagos, the *National Geographic Islander* and the *National Geographic Endeavour*, giving us oversight and control that many others just don't have.
- 6 Year-round Galápagos and Lindblad Expeditions:** Our ships operate year-round, each offering full-week itineraries, with the *National Geographic Endeavour* departing every Friday, and the *National Geographic Islander* departing every Saturday.
- 7 Technological tools add to the guest experience:** No other company can match our tools for exploration, with video microscopes, plasma screens, Undersea Specialists, hydrophones, Video Chroniclers, splash cams and daily expedition reports; all of these tools add significant value to the experience of exploring the Galápagos.
